1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

3. GRANTS RECEIVED

During the year, grants were received as below:

From the LPA Funds, £8750, as a contribution towards the salary of a part time education officer, who enables Rainbow Turtle's Fair Trade Education Project.

Renfrewshire Council, Celebrating Renfrewshire Fund. £750, a contribution towards the Fair Trade Education Project. This was awarded where young people voted for their favourite projects within the Local Partnership Areas (LPA)

4. INVESTMENT
