Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1)(d) of the 2006 Accounts Regulations does not apply. Basis of independent examiner's statement

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2022

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

- (a) The accounts have been prepared in accordance with The Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006, and Statement of Recommended Practice Accounting and Reporting by Charities.
- (b) Income is credited in the Accounts on the day of receipt.

2. CHARITY STATUS

Rainbow Turtle is recognised by H M Revenue and Customs and by OSCR as a charity under Scottish Charity Number SC034097.

3. GRANTS RECEIVED

During the year, grants were received as below:

From the LPA Funds, £8411, as a contribution towards the salary and expenses of a part time education officer, who enables Rainbow Turtle's Fair Trade Education Project.

Renfrewshire Council, £147.80 towards expenses for a schools' competition. This funding has been carried forward

4. INVESTMENT

Rainbow Turtle holds 2 ordinary shares, representing 100% of the issued share capital of Rainbow Turtle Just Trading Ltd which is incorporated in Scotland.

5. Management expenses now include a contribution to office rent on a monthly basis. A one off cost of £1000 was also paid for legal services, whilst exploring a move to SCIO status
